Why Online Speech Therapy?

Online SLPs manage the same responsibilities as onsite therapists: they administer assessments and complete evaluation reports, write and update IEPs, case manage, attend IEP meetings, track and report on student progress, schedule therapy sessions, and communicate with parents and staff. All services are directed by each student's IEP or 504 plan, and are delivered one-on-one, in small-group, and in classroom settings.

Online speech-language services provide:

- Relief from excessive caseloads for onsite clinicians
- Flexible scheduling options
- Ability to serve homebound and remote students, as well as students from different sites
- Ability to serve early intervention population, as well as preschool through transition age students across all ability groups
- SLPs who are certified to administer bilingual evaluations and interventions

How Does Online Speech Therapy Work?

Our speech-language therapists use live, interactive video to work directly with students and their support team—teachers, primary support personnel, onsite SLPs, school psychologists, and/or parents and other caregivers. Using the same techniques and materials as onsite therapy, PresenceLearning integrates live audio and video to facilitate high fidelity, real-time interactions. PresenceLearning therapy includes an online library of 100,000+ therapy activities, exercises, and interactive resources; schedule management; and progress tracking on IEP and 504 goals.

Sessions take place anywhere that has both a computer and an internet connection: a resource room, a classroom, a computer lab, the library/media center, or another area in the school—or even at home for virtual or homebound students.
