### How Do Online Psychoeducational Assessments Work?

Using the same techniques and materials as onsite evaluations, PresenceLearning school psychologists use our secure online platform to utilize a combination of direct student assessment, standardized assessment tools, student work samples, clinical observation (via webcam), records review, parent/teacher/student interviews, developmental/medical histories, and norm-referenced-standardized rating scales.

Remote school psychologists start by joining the assessment planning meeting with the school team to determine the appropriate plan. Students are tested individually in a quiet, confidential environment, monitored by an onsite proctor who is directed by the remote school psychologist and has no clinical duties. The stimulus books are licensed from the publishers and collaboratively digitized by PresenceLearning. Students view the stimuli on the computer screen and respond just as they would in person.

The student also uses a document camera that enables the school psychologist to observe students as they complete their responses in the booklet or use manipulatives. Once the test is complete, the onsite proctor sends the student response booklet to the school psychologist, who scores it and writes a report which they share at the results and eligibility

#### Pioneering Research Studies Demonstrate Equivalency

In an effort to discover whether psychoeducational assessments administered online are an appropriate solution, Dr. A. Jordan Wright, a researcher from Empire State College, SUNY (now at NYU), undertook an equivalency study using the WJ IV®. PAR Publishing has since released an equivalency study for the RIAS-2.

Based on the results of these equivalency studies, the online administration of cognitive ability and academic achievement assessments by remote examiners is a viable way for all schools to expand their capacity to support students by delivering psychoeducational assessments.
